

# SCHS CANNED FOOD DRIVE

Today marks the official start of the annual Student Council CANNED FOOD DRIVE. The Ministerial Alliance is again counting on our support. SCHS supplies the bulk of the canned food distributed each year by this organization.

For us to beat last year's donation, we hope that all Homeroom classes will participate in this year's drive. Please encourage your Homeroom class to participate! We need your help. It takes some effort, but you might consider putting students in charge of the project. This competition is something that ALL students can participate in. The official contest rules are as follows:

- Two Homeroom classes may combine.
- It is legal for students to collect door to door.
- It is legal to accept a donation from an area business or organization, but you may not set up a collection site there.
- You may not use the school phones to call and ask area businesses for donations. You may not use cell phones during the day to make calls. This must be done outside of school.
- Cans will be counted as follows:
  - Baby food counts as 1 can
  - Small cans (individual juice) count as ½ can
  - Any can over 20 oz. counts as 2 cans (no exceptions)
  - Boxes or packages (rice, noodles) count as 1 can
  - Ramen noodles count as ½ can
  - Fruit counts as 1 ½ cans
  - Soft drinks and dog/cat food do not count
  - Home canned items cannot be accepted
  - Small jello boxes count as ½ can

**The contest ends on November 19, 2021 at 8:00 am.** Each class is responsible for counting their own cans and bringing them to the center stairs as soon as 1<sup>st</sup> hour begins. At that time, we would like a copy of your class list to be turned in with your total count. After your total count is turned in, no more cans may be added! Student Council will provide a pizza party to the winning class. The second place class will receive donuts and milk. Please contact Mr. Donoho if you have any questions.
